**TYRONE TOWNSHIP TAX COLLECTOR FEES
ORDINANCE NO. 60**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF A FEE FOR A TAX
DUPLICATE.

WHEREAS, Tyrone Township may establish reasonable fees for the services of municipal officials, including the Township's Tax Collector; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 11, Part 6, §11-601 of the Codified Ordinances of Tyrone Township authorizes the collection of fees by the Township Tax Collector relating to returned checks and for tax certifications, but does not authorize fees for requests for tax duplicates; and

WHEREAS, Tyrone Township wishes to authorize a fee to be charged by the Tyrone Township Tax Collector for requests for tax duplicates.

NOW THEREFORE, be it **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of Tyrone Township as follows:

1. Tyrone Township hereby imposes a fee to be assessed to each person, firm, corporation or other entity requesting a tax duplicate from the Tyrone Township Tax Collector.
2. The amount of the fee authorized by this Ordinance shall be set by Resolution of Tyrone Township from time to time.
3. All Ordinances or portions of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.
4. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause, or section of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, or section of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Tyrone Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, or section not been included herein.
5. This Ordinance shall be codified in the Codified Ordinances of Tyrone Township, Adams County, and shall amend such codification as necessary to Codify this Ordinance, including the addition of Subsection C. to Chapter 11, Part 6, §11-601 thereof.

6. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days from the date of its enactment.
