Mobile Emergency Operations Center (EOC):

NAREMA is exploring whether there is interest among NAREMA municipalities in sharing the Township's EOC.

District 3 Notices of Violation:

Mosley made a motion to authorize Constable Fitting to serve Notices of Violation to those remaining on the District 3 Septic System Noncompliance List. Seymore seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion carried unanimously.

New Business:

Adams County Agricultural Land Preservation:

Ellen Dayhoff, Program Administrator Adams County Ag Land Preservation Program provided an overview of the Program. Applicants apply to preserve their farms through a variety of funding sources. One farm in Tyrone Township has qualified for consideration.

Resignations:

Sydney McFadden' has resigned as Tyrone Township Secretary as of 1/12/23—The Board stated many Thanks and well wishes for her future. Mosley made motion to accept. Dashoff 2nd the motion. A vote was taken and the motion carried unanimously.

WWTF Barscreen Enclosure:

Travis Martin 1/11 update: When it was very cold the Operator recommended to insulate the Barscreen. Mr. Martin thought that we should have to enclose it. Bill Hill (Head Township Engineer) recommends that we DO NOT enclose it, but instead install a wind blocker to keep safe from cold weather/snow etc. Mr. Martin has not yet had a chance to reach out to an inspector about obtaining this wind blocker but will by Friday 1/13/23. There is a thermostat control for colder weather but not enough to guarantee the expensive cost of the Barscreen if needed to be replaced due to cold conditions.
