ORDINANCE NO. 2025-01

**AN ORDINANCE OF TYRONE TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
SETTING SUPERVISOR COMPENSATION**

WHEREAS, Tyrone Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, (the “Township”) is a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 94 of 2024, which sets forth parameters for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class, and;

WHEREAS, the Act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of not more than 4,999 may be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$ 3,145 per year and;

WHEREAS, the population of Tyrone Township is 2,145 per the official US Census of 2020 and does not exceed a population of 4,999; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Tyrone Township, Adams County desires to set annual compensation in accordance with Act 94 of 2024.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of Tyrone Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Each supervisor of Tyrone Township entering office after the effective date of this Ordinance shall receive compensation as a supervisor in the annual amount equal to \$3,134.00.

SECTION 2. Such compensation shall be paid to Supervisors in monthly installments of \$262.08.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All provisions of previous Ordinances of Tyrone Township which are contrary to this Ordinance are expressly repealed.

SECTION 4. Savings Clause. In all other respects, the Tyrone Township Ordinances shall remain as previously enacted and ordained.


SECTION 5. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable, and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or part thereof is, for any reason, held to be invalid to be unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of any remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or part of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. Codification. This Ordinance shall become a part of the Codified Ordinances of Tyrone Township upon enactment.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.


