ORDINANCE NO. 61

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TYRONE,
ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING §8-204.A.
OF THE TYRONE TOWNSHIP CODIFIED ORDINANCES
ENTITLED BILLS FOR SEWER RENTALS AND CHARGES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Tyrone (the “Township”), Adams County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 8-204.A. of the Tyrone Township Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

§8-204. Bills For Sewer Rentals And Charges.

A. Bills for sewer rentals or charges shall be mailed by the Township to the owners of property receiving sewer service. Said sewer rentals are payable at par by the 15th day of each calendar month and are subject to a one time ten percent (10%) penalty if not paid on or before the 22nd day of the month that the sewer rentals or charges are first due. Thereafter, interest at a rate of ten percent (10%) per annum on unpaid sewer rentals or charges shall be assessed from the date of the filing of a municipal lien therefore until paid in full. The sewer rentals herein provided shall be collected and enforced in a manner deemed appropriate or necessary by the Township, exercising such remedies provided by law for the assessment and collection of municipal claims and the enforcement of municipal liens under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity

shall not affect the validity of any remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted and enacted as if such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision had not been included therein.

SECTION 3: REPEALER.

Any ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE.
