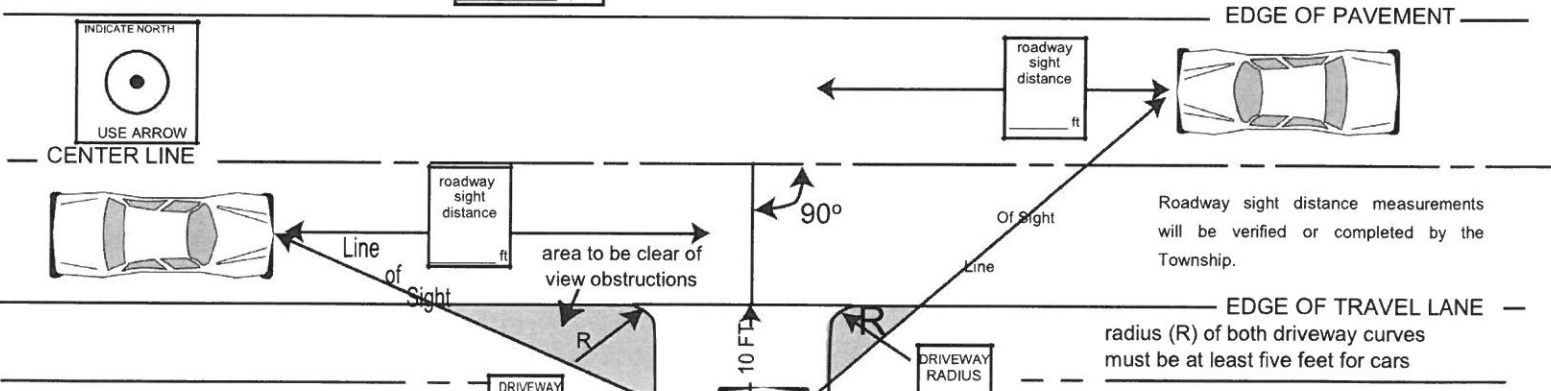

DRIVEWAY PERMIT

OWNER ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

This Acknowledgement is to advise you that, as a condition of the issuance of your Driveway Permit, you, as the owner of the property located at \_\_\_\_\_, are responsible for any damages to the public roadway caused by you or your contractors or subcontractors hired to complete the construction.

Your responsibility includes damage caused by loading or unloading heavy equipment and any use of heavy vehicles brought in to complete the construction. Damage to the roadway includes, but is not limited to: the asphalt, the sub grade of the roadway, any roadway culverts and drainage areas along the edge of the roadway, etc.

A Tyrone Township representative will document any existing roadway issues prior to the permit being issued. The Township will monitor the roadway area during construction and bring any identified issues to your attention. You are reminded to review the Tyrone Township Driveway Ordinance, specifically, Section 13-6 as to Temporary driveways. It will be your responsibility to ensure that any debris on the roadway is cleaned each day after operation.
